2	We would like clarification regarding what firms or key personnel of a DB Team would be considered a "Major Participant" as identified in section 3.1(b) of the RFQ. Would a supporting design subcontractor to the lead A/E design firm be considered a "Major Participant"?	Refer to Exhibit A for the definition of a Major Participant. A supporting design subcontractor would not be a Major Participant if the supporting design subcontractor firm is not a Designer-of-Record or Design Lead.
3	If the supporting design subcontractor provided different staff for each DB Team they are on, would this be an acceptable approach to comply with a potential conflict?	If the "supporting design subcontractor" is not a Major Participant then they can be on different DB Teams.
